When we drill for natural gas, large trucks are used to move equipment in and out of the drill site. We recognize that this heavy equipment can cause unanticipated wear and tear on local roads. That is why we will work with local townships, counties and state agencies needed to repair any problems caused by our operations.

HOW DO I KNOW IF I OWN MY OIL & GAS RIGHTS?

A search of your deed or property title can disclose whether you own your oil & gas rights. Title searches are needed to confirm ownership.

HOW DO I DECIDE WHO TO LEASE TO?

There are many considerations during leasing. One of the most important questions is who will produce your oil and gas. The operating company is the one that will actually drill and produce your oil and gas and is not necessarily the same one that offers you the lease. You should consider the reputation and stability of the operating company and their commitment to the community as demonstrated through corporate contributions and civic service.

HOW LONG BEFORE I RECEIVE A ROYALTY PAYMENT?

You will receive royalty payments when natural gas is actually produced and sold from a well drilled. Once a lease is signed, it could be months or years before a well is drilled.

HOW DOES DRILLING AFFECT ME?

Even if you don't own your oil and gas rights, the economic benefits from developing natural gas will provide economic growth for Appalachia in the form of new jobs and added revenue into local townships which translates to vibrant businesses and communities.
